- Students log in to the portal 5 times as much as parents





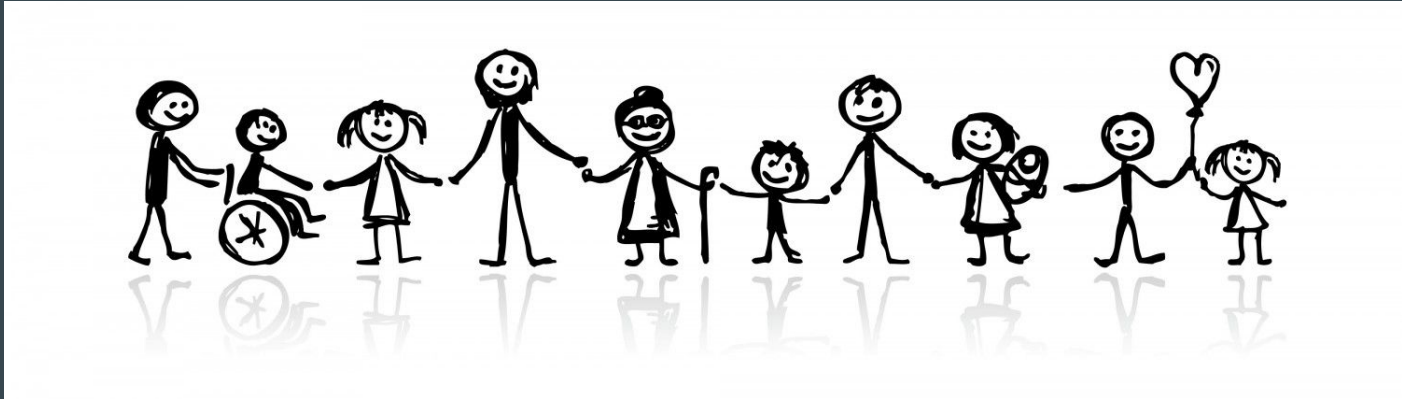
# Support Teams
