Definition of CSB:

A Community Service Board is the primary provider of public mental health, substance abuse, and intellectual disabilities services. A continuum of services span from outreach and prevention through intensive psychiatric care, provided by highly clinically-oriented service professionals with expertise in these service areas.

Most of their services enter into the system through intake, emergency intervention, hospital liaison, court services, and outreach.

Services can include medical care, psychiatric care, therapy, case management, support services, housing support, and outreach.

Although supported with public funds, services are highly dependent on ability to bill insurance providers, primarily Medicaid.
