

## RESOURCES FOR THE UNINSURED /UNDERINSURED

### **COVER VIRGINIA:**

Virginia offers several low and no cost health insurance programs for eligible children, pregnant women and adults. ### **SOUTHEASTERN VIRGINIA HEALTH SYSTEM (SEVHS):**

*Formerly known as PICH (Peninsula Institute for Community Health)*

Is community-based health center that provides medical and dental care to everybody. SEVHS accepts patients with or without health insurance. Payments for services are based upon a sliding fee scale. You should bring a government issued picture identification card that is unexpired, your insurance card if insured, a list of any medications that you are currently taking and, of course, your copayment. To apply for the sliding fee scale, you must bring your last 2 pay stubs or other proof of household income. Plan on arriving for your appointment at least 30 minutes early to complete the patient registration process. ***Must call for an appointment.***
