Job Description:

The Student Representative must also attend the Superintendent's Advisory Group to obtain information and opinions from their peers.

Requirements:

- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher & no failing grades
- Must attend a Hampton City Public High School
- Must be a rising Junior or Senior
- Must not have any in or out of school disciplinary issues
- Must be able to attend all open School Board meetings beginning July 2016

Student Must Demonstrate:

- Leadership skills & experience
- Communication skills (both written & verbal)
- Listening skills
- Time management
- An ability to handle multiple tasks
- An open-mind to opinions that differ from their own
- Respect for the student-teacher-principal relationship
